

Pass Mark for CAS Online Course 2

CAS Online Course 2 was developed for the CAS by The Institutes. The Institutes administer the course with the exam being offered by computer-based testing at Prometric test centers.

The grading and pass mark for CAS Online Course 2 is similar to that of other CPCU exams that have a pass mark around 70 percent.

For the first few administrations of the exam for CAS Online Course 2 in 2011, the exams will not be auto-scored, i.e., candidates will not receive their grades at the testing center. After completing the exam, candidates will receive a written confirmation that they took the exam. After the testing window has closed, the results will be verified and final grades will be released by The Institutes within three weeks.

After final grades are determined, candidates will receive an e-mail from The Institutes stating that their grades are available. Candidates may then log into their account on The Institutes Web Site (www.TheInstitutes.org) to access their grades. Candidates should go to the Web site and click on the log in button in the upper right portion of the screen. On the log in screen, candidates will be able to enter their ID and PIN or follow the prompts to obtain those if they do not know them.

The grade report for each candidate will show the candidate's overall score on the exam in ten point increments (e.g., 60 to 69%, 70 to 79%, and so on). It will similarly show the candidate's performance by assignment using those same ten point increments. Numerical scores are not released.

Once grades have been released to candidates, The Institutes will send them directly to the CAS Office to be added to the candidates' admissions records.
