

**Frederic J. Hunt Jr. (FCAS 1959)**

**1923-2014**

**THE CAS VOLUNTEER**

Frederic J. Hunt Jr., 90, of Coatesville, Pennsylvania, died on December 3, 2014.

He was born in East Providence, Rhode Island in 1923, the son of Josephine (Johnson) and Frederic J. Hunt. Hunt served honorably in the U.S. Navy during World War II and graduated from Brown University. He worked for

Insurance Company of North America in Philadelphia from 1955 until his retirement in 1988.

After earning his FCAS, Hunt began volunteering for the CAS in earnest — a commitment spanning two decades.

Hunt volunteered for such CAS committees as Examination, Education and Examination, Publicity, and Review of Papers. From 1964-66, Hunt served on the CAS Council, a precursor to the CAS Board.

He wrote and cowrote several *Proceedings* papers and discussions, including a 10-year history of homeowners insurance published in 1962.

Hunt is survived by his wife, Marjorie (nee Whittemore); sons, Peter W. and Jonathan F. (Lisa); two sisters, Elizabeth Schumann and Constance DelGizzi; and two grandsons. He was preceded in death by his sister Ruth Schwacha.
