

CASE Scholarship

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the scholarship is to further students' interest in the property/casualty actuarial profession and to encourage the pursuit of the CAS designations at institutions in the Southeastern U.S.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, an applicant must be currently attending a college or university as a full-time student in one of the following Southeastern states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, or Virginia. The applicant must be continuing as a full-time student for the academic year to which the scholarship would apply. Incoming freshmen / first-year students are not eligible for the scholarship. An applicant must have demonstrated high scholastic achievement and strong interest in mathematics or a mathematics-related field.

Preference will be given to applicants who have not yet won the CASE Scholarship or any other actuarial-related scholarship. Applicants should demonstrate interest in the actuarial profession, mathematical aptitude and communication skills.

PROCEDURE:

An application is considered complete when it includes:

- 1. The 4-page CASE Scholarship application and attached essay.
- 2. Two (2) nomination forms (sample included in this application), preferably completed by instructors and/or advisors at your educational institution who know you well. Only 2 nomination forms will be considered.
- 3. A current official transcript.

Completed applications are due by <u>May 1st</u> each year. Additional applications are available online at the CASE Web site at <u>www.casact.org/affiliates/case/</u>. You will be notified of award decisions by August 1st.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of individual merit. The CASE Scholarship Program will award up to two \$1,500 scholarships to deserving students for each academic year.

- 1. The 4-page CASE Scholarship application and attached essay.
- 2. Two (2) nomination forms, preferably completed by instructors and/or advisors at your educational institution who know you well. Only 2 nomination forms will be considered.
- 3. Current official college transcript. Indicate whether the academic term is semester, trimester, or quarter. If the current transcript shows grades for only one academic term, then also provide the official transcript from your prior educational institution.
