

Casualty Actuaries of the Southeast

CASE Scholarship

OBJECTIVE:

The objective of the scholarship is to further students' interest in the property/casualty actuarial profession and to encourage the pursuit of the CAS designations at institutions in the Southeastern U.S.

ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible, an applicant must be currently attending a college or university as a full-time student in one of the following Southeastern states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, or Virginia. The applicant must be continuing as a full-time student for the academic year to which the scholarship would apply. Incoming freshmen / first-year students are not eligible for the scholarship. An applicant must have demonstrated high scholastic achievement and strong interest in mathematics or a mathematics-related field.

Preference will be given to applicants who have not yet won the CASE Scholarship or any other actuarial-related scholarship. Applicants should demonstrate interest in the actuarial profession, mathematical aptitude and communication skills.

PROCEDURE:

An application is considered complete when it includes:

1. The CASE Scholarship application.
2. Personal Statement.
3. Nomination form.
4. Current official transcript.
5. Resume (Optional).

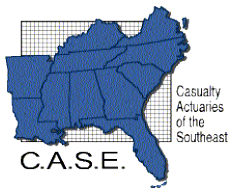
Completed applications are due by August 10. You will be notified of award decisions by September 10.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarships are awarded on the basis of individual merit. The CASE Scholarship Program will award up to two \$1,500 scholarships to deserving students for each academic year.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Currently attending a college or university as a full-time student (i.e., incoming freshmen not eligible) in one of the following states: Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, or Virginia
- Demonstrated strong interest in mathematics or mathematics-related field
- High scholastic achievement
- Applicants should demonstrate mathematical aptitude, communication skills, and interest in the actuarial profession

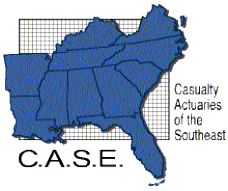
To consider your application, CASE must receive the following by AUGUST 10th immediately prior to the academic year

which the scholarship will apply. It is the applicant's responsibility to assure that materials are received on time.

1. The 4-page CASE Scholarship application.
2. Personal statement- 1 page essay.
3. Nomination form, preferably completed by an instructor and/or advisor at your educational institution who is familiar with your work.
4. Current official college transcript. Indicate whether the academic term is semester, trimester, or quarter. If the current transcript shows grades for only one academic term, then also provide the official transcript from your prior educational institution.
5. Resume (Optional)- Including details on educational record, employment & internships, extracurricular and personal activities, and actuarial examination record.
