General Guidelines

- You are recommended to work in groups of up to 3 members.
- This competition will have two rounds. No switching of team members.

Question

Round 1 [Format: Report. Weightage: 60%]

Data Source: https://insurancecouncil.com.au/industry-members/data-hub/ (Suggest to use the "Historical Normalised Catastrophe list – July 2025")

- Perform Exploratory Data Analysis on the dataset:
 - Explain trends in the frequency and severity of catastrophes based on historical losses.
 - Describe correlations between the type of catastrophe and the various claims type.
 - Explain the original and normalized loss values.
 Trend the values to 2026 and explain the methodology.
 - Validate or debunk the notion of climate change and occurrences of natural catastrophes.
- Explain traditional reinsurance products/ government support available to manage catastrophe losses and how this helps direct insurers.
- Elaborate on the pricing risk and reserving risk in the mentioned reinsurance products.
- How do catastrophe models supplement historical data?

Rules for Round 1:

- 1. You may supplement your analysis with verifiable, external data sources. Ensure the sources are cited accordingly.
- 2. You may decide the type of media for your report, which is a judging criterion itself. The report must not be more than 10 pages, including references and appendices.
- 3. Due to the nature of the dataset, the report is highly recommended to be in English.

Advice in preparing your submission

- We are looking for responses that simple, not overly complicated and best display your ability in communicating results to the audience.
- There are many solutions available. Entries will be assessed on the basis of originality of ideas, logical flow between explaining the various concepts and communication skills.
