	<p>Short-Term Contributor: Joins temporary efforts with clear start/end</p> <p>Examples: Task Forces, Speaker, Student Central Summer Program, Exam Consultant (Seasonal)</p> <p>Experience: All Levels</p> <p>Time: 1–4 hrs/month</p>
	<p>Ongoing Contributor: Has an ongoing role in a group or program</p> <p>Examples: Working Group Member, Exam Writer/Grader (Seasonal)</p> <p>Experience: ACAS/FCAS, Affiliate</p> <p>Time: 5–10 hrs/month</p>
	<p>Team Leader: Takes on ownership or leads a small team</p> <p>Examples: Working Group Chair, Project Lead, Regional Affiliate Officer</p> <p>Experience: Experienced ACAS/FCAS</p> <p>Time: 8–12 hrs/month</p>
	<p>Strategic Leader: Oversees broader strategic efforts</p> <p>Examples: Executive Council, Board of Directors</p> <p>Experience: Senior Leader</p> <p>Time: 10–15 hrs/month</p>
