### Challenge / Opportunity

- Bad news in first half of 2015…
  - 228,000,000 records breached
  - 1,860 breaches
  - 78% of incidents result of hacking
  - 95% of all exposed records result of hacking

...According to Risk Based security study

- Insurance in first half of 2015…
  - Less than 20% buyers overall
  - Less than 6% buyers in small / mid-sized companies

...According to ABI research study



### The market today

- 30+ markets with core of 'specialist markets'
- Bifurcation of appetites:
  - Larger risks; experts
  - Small business; generalists
- Approx \$350M+ limits available
- Approx \$2.5B premium in 2015
- Various Growth Estimates
  - Between \$7.5M and \$20M in 2020












#### Defender-Detection Deficit









  - vendor management








#### Post Bind Risk Control Measures
