


### Components Affected




- WC Medical Long-tailed
  - In California 32% of losses paid more than 8 years from injury
     Payment patterns slowing over time
- Settlement of future medical
  - Allowed in many states
  - 16% of 2008 California medical benefits paid directly to injured workers (\$700 million)
  - Approximately two–thirds of California permanent disability claims settled via compromise and release
  - Can impact applicant attorney awards
- · Impact of aging workforce
  - California Medicare 65+ population to increase by 35% by 2030
- Frictional costs





## Medicare Set-Asides



- All costs included in medical (2006)
  - Evaluation costs
  - Cost of set-asides
  - Administration costs
- Augmented annual survey of PD Claims (2009)
  - Set-aside created
  - Cost of set-asides
- · Annual medical payment call to be augmented

## Medicare Conditional Liens



- Annual medical payment call to be augmented
  - Not a payment to provider or injured worker
  - May involve claims that were closed for many years
